This course will prepare you for working in the aged care sector and studying the CHC 33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing & Disability) at Yarraville Community Centre.

This course aims to develop learner's literacy and numeracy capabilities and understanding of aged care as a pathway to the Certificate III in Individual Support.
